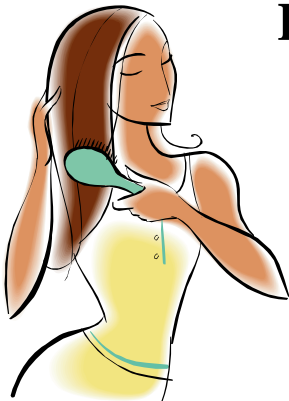
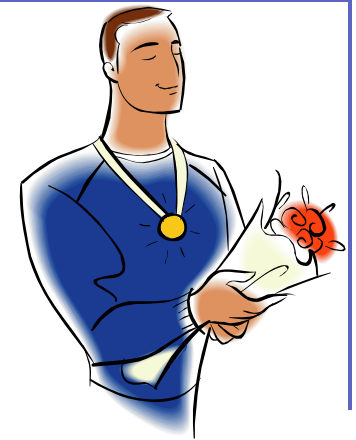

A House is NOT a Home.

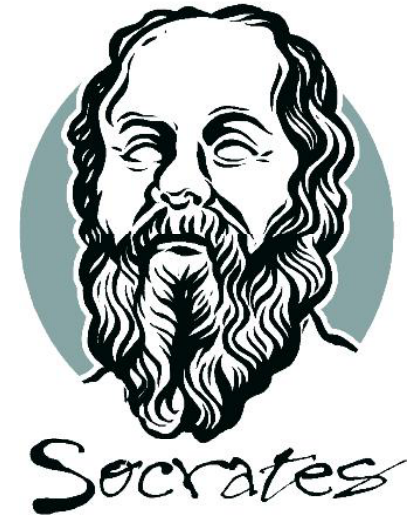
**Do we take our family for granted?**

Galatians 6: 9 And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not.

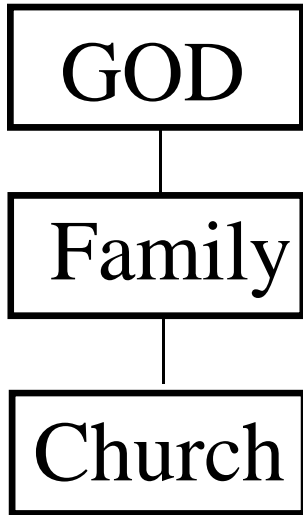
### 4. Laugh / Smile

## Define Commitment?

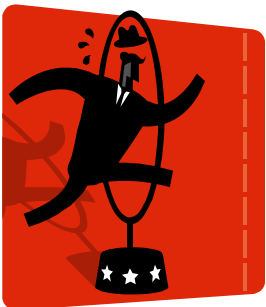
### commitment



**1 a:** consignment to a penal or mental institution

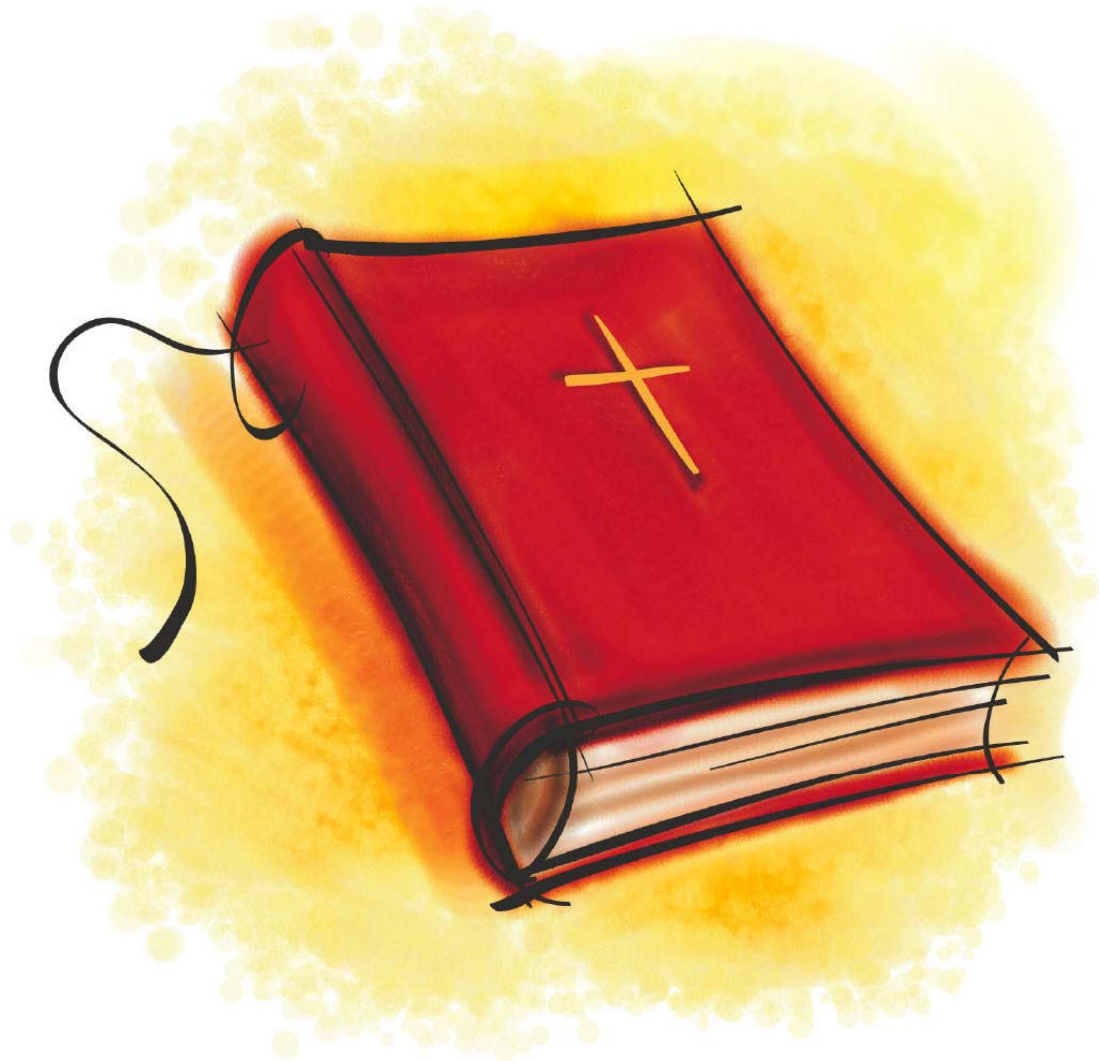




# Conclusion
